Wolfgang graduated from the School of Applied Environmental Sciences, University of Natal, Pietermaritzburg. Wolfgang majored in Zoology and Grassland Science, studied an honours degree in the latter, and completed a master's degree through the department of Range and Forage Resources. He was awarded the Grassland Society of Southern Africa medal for being the outstanding MSc student in Range and Forage Science in his graduation year. He has been employed as a research assistant and managed a number of projects at the Ukulinga research facility in Pietermaritzburg, and has been involved in a variety of research assignments including mine dump re-vegetation and elephant impact assessment. Ecologically his interest lies primarily in vegetation dynamics, and how man influences these processes. His specific expertise lies in grassland science and savanna ecology, and has worked in this field in Zululand (Mkuze, Enkwaleni, Pongola), the KwaZulu-Natal Midlands (Pietermaritzburg, Weenen, Nottingham Road, Underberg) and Northern Province (Phalaborwa, Limpopo). Wolfgang was contracted as an environmental planner for Ezemvelo KZN Wildlife reviewing biodiversity aspects of EIA. Since starting AFZELIA, Wolfgang has been involved in all facets of the Environmental Impact Assessment process, including specialist consulting (*inter alia* biodiversity assessments, ecological screenings, roads and pipeline assessments) and managing the EIA process. He has over eight years of consulting experience.
